## 4<sup>th</sup> Bowl Scripture and Associated Scriptures

<u>Revelation 7:9-15</u> – (Summary) A great multitude, clothed in white robes with palm branches in their hands, are in front of the throne with all the angels, elders, and four living creatures around the throne. The great multitude are the ones coming out of the great tribulation.

<u>Revelation 7:16</u> – "They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any SCORCHING heat."

<u>Revelation 16:8-9</u> – "The fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and it was allowed to SCORCH people with fire. They were SCORCHED by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues..."

<u>Isaiah 24:6</u> – "Therefore a curse devours the earth, and its inhabitants suffer for their guilt; therefore, the inhabitants of the earth are SCORCHED and few men are left."

<u>Isaiah 26:21</u> – "For behold, the Lord is coming out from his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity, and the earth will disclose the blood shed on it, and will no more cover its slain."

Jeremiah 25:33 – "And those pierced by the Lord on that day shall extend from one end of the earth to the other. They shall not be lamented, or gathered, or buried, they shall be dung on the surface of the ground."

Summary – <u>Revelation 7:16</u> tells us that the great multitude that came out of the Great Tribulation will be raptured before God pours out the 4<sup>th</sup> Bowl judgment of scorching heat. <u>Isaiah 24:6</u> tells us that the few men going into the Millennium with Jesus will have been scorched with God's 4<sup>th</sup> Bowl judgment. This means that all non-believers left on the earth after the Rapture, will be scorched, both Jew and Gentile. When Jesus returns, 30 days after the Rapture, those going into the Millennium with him will be 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the Israelites alive when Jesus stops the Battle of Armageddon and those outside of Israel that did not take the mark of the beast.

There will not be enough inhabitants left in the world to bury those that had taken the mark of the beast except in Israel. There will be over two million Israelites left in Israel after Jesus returns, and it will take them seven months to bury the dead there per Ezekiel 39:12.
